Domaine Paterianakis, Meleses

The Domaine Paterianakis is located in Melesses, in the Peza wine region, right in the center of Crete. It was founded in 1988 by Giorgos Paterianakis, with a focus on the creation of a quality Cretan wine.

The Domaine is open almost all year round. If you would like to enjoy a magical view along with an authentic organic wine visit the Domaine for an unforgettable experience. The distance from Blue View Villas to Domaine Paterianakis in Meleses is 24 km or 14.91 miles.









Lyrarakis Wines, Alagni

Lyrarakis Wines is a family-owned winery, established in 1966 on the island of Crete, Greece.

During these five decades, the family has devoted itself to the revival of indigenous, almost extinct, grape varieties of Crete like Dafni, Plyto, Melissaki and others, vinificating wines that highlight their distinctive character.

A guided tour in the vineyards, cellar and vine-museum is included. The distance from Blue View Villas to Lyrarakis Wines is 22.91 km or 14.23 miles.











Miliarakis Wines – Minos, Peza

Wine is an experience, a sensory feast. This is why *Miliarakis' Winery* has created wine tasting and wine presentation premises at their facilities in *Peza*.

The company is trying to promote the Cretan vineyard through its varieties, innovating and adopting methods never before utilized in Crete.

MINOS is developing a vineyard comprising of privately owned and contract areas covering 220 km2 and continues to work with local farmers, aiming at securing high quality grapes.

The distance from Blue View Villas to Miliarakis Wines is 22.23 km or 13.81 miles.

<u> Vassilakis Estate</u>, Neapoli – Lasithi

The story of the Vassilakis family olive business is interwoven with the history of the Mirambello Valley. It begins more than 150 years ago when the first Manolis Vassilakis realized his vision to build a "fabrica" (olive mill) to press the olives harvested from the millennium-old trees of his olive grove.

He searched the area for just the right stone, a huge millstone, and with the help of several men rolled it for days over the uneven ground up the hill to Agia Sophia village. The stone olive mill was one of the first in the valley, producing life-giving olive oil for the family and their little community for many years. They welcome thousands of visitors every summer from all over the world. In response to popular demand, they offer many guided tours and unique tasting experiences. The distance from Blue View Villas to Vassilakis Estate is 16.8 km or 10.43 miles.
